Phi Gamma Zeta Scholarship - Overview

Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated, Phi Gamma Zeta Chapter will award a \$1,500 scholarship to a female residing in Hopewell or Prince George, Virginia and entering a United States college or university in the summer or fall of 2025. The scholarship recognizes academic distinction as well as strong character and personal qualities.

Eligibility Criteria/ Applicant must:	
Be a current female residing in Hopewell or Prince George, Virginia. Be anticipating completion of a high school diploma in the spring of 2025 or have completed. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 or score at least a 580 on the GED Exam. Have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in at least twenty (20) hours a service and extracurricular activities. Be entering into a United States college or university in the summer or fall of 2025.
